Reading/Homework Diaries

Please note the following changes to procedures for signing the weekly reading/homework diaries for KS2 classes.

Please sign your child's diary each week after having read any comments from the teacher. This is so we can ensure that the flow of information between yourself and school is maintained. If the diary is not signed by the Friday, a signature must be put in by the end of the next week at the latest, otherwise that week's merit cannot be awarded. KS2 children know about this to help them take responsibility for their own day to day organisation.

P.E. Kit

I have noticed that a significant number of KS2 children have not been able to take part in the P.E. lessons recently because they have not had their kit with them. Teachers have in the past dealt with this as they see fit. We have come to the conclusion that the following incentives to be properly prepared for P.E. will help the situation.
