

## **ALL SAINTS'C.E. PRIMARY SCHOOL, ALREWAS.**

### **Admissions Policy**

It is intended that the number of pupils to be admitted to this school at the normal age of entry in the current academic year will not exceed 33.

If the number of pupils seeking admission to the school exceeds the number of places available, then the following order of priority will be used:

- a) Pupils living within the catchment area of the school.
- b) Pupils who would, in the first year to which the application relates, have an elder brother or sister in attendance at the school.
- c) Pupils who satisfy both of the following tests:
  - 1) they are distinguished from the great majority of other applicants either on medical grounds which are supported by a medical report, obtained by parents, specifying the medical advantage of the child attending the preferred school compared with the normal catchment area school or by other exceptional circumstances material to the choice of the school (i.e. the circumstances of the child, not the economic or social circumstances of the parent); and
  - 2) they would suffer hardship if they were unable to attend the school.
- d) Other pupils arranged in order of priority according to how near their home addresses are from the school, measurements being by the nearest walking route.

Pupils are admitted to the school full-time in September at the commencement of the academic year in which they attain their fifth birthday.

The school is also able to offer a part-time place for children at the commencement of the term after their fourth birthday. The dates for admission will be as follows:

For birthdays 1st September - 31st December                      following Spring Term;

For birthdays 1st January - 31st March                              following Summer Term;

Children whose birthdays are between 1st April - 31st August will be admitted full-time the following September. In accordance with statutory requirements, the part-time sessions will be 2.5 hours per day.
